## **CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECK POLICY**

### **Purpose of the Policy**

Theatre Britain highly values the safety of all the people who participate and assist with accomplishing its Mission. As a result, we want to take measures and attempt safeguards to protect all involved from potential harm. Theatre Britain has implemented this policy to apply to all participants with Theatre Britain.

### **Criminal History Record Check Policy**

Theatre Britain will conduct criminal history record checks on all participants in any capacity on an annual basis. Individuals may be permanently disqualified from holding positions if they have a history of:

- Any offense against a child
- Sexual offenses
- Offenses involving an act of violence, injury to or death of another
- Weapons related offenses
- Theft related offenses including fraud or forgery
- Felony drug offenses
- Stalking or harassment related offenses
- Other offenses deemed by the Board of Directors to cause a potential compromise to the safety, security or well-being of those involved with Theatre Britain.

A conviction for a criminal offense that is a misdemeanor non-violent in nature will not automatically disqualify an applicant for a position with Theatre Britain.

### **Age Scope**

Criminal History Checks will not be conducted on participants who are under 18 years of age since criminal records are not publicly available for juveniles.

### **Costs**

Theatre Britain will absorb the costs associated with the criminal history checks.

### **Privacy**

The privacy of the information obtained by Theatre Britain through the criminal history check will be respected for all participants. Your information is confidential and will be shared only with Theatre Britain board members who have a need to know. All forms gathered for purposes of conducting the criminal history check will either remain in secure files or be destroyed upon completion.

### **Due Process**

If a criminal conviction is found, the participant will be given a copy of the criminal history report to review for accuracy prior to a final decision concerning participation being made by Theatre Britain. If the record is thought to be inaccurate, the participant shall have the opportunity to present information correcting or clarifying the inaccuracy. As a general rule, participants will be precluded from service if the criminal history check shows a court imposed penalty for a violent crime, sexual offense, financial crime, or felony drug related crime. A final decision concerning participation will be made by the Theatre Britain Board of Directors and when necessary, legal counsel.
